SAMSI Summer Program

The SAMSI 2009 Summer Program on Psychometrics will be held on July 7-17, 2009. The goal of the program is stimulate collaborations between researchers in the psychometric and statistical communities leading to a well-defined, concrete list of specific research directions that will facilitate methodological development in related psychometric/statistical models.

The first week of the program of the program will be devoted to extended, tutorial-style talks during morning sessions, and contributed and invited research talks during the afternoons. During the second week, three working groups will convene to discuss current, practical applications of methodology presented during the first week of the program. These working groups will focus on (a) the analysis of patient reported outcomes (PROs), (b) journal and grant peer review, and (c) cognitive diagnostic models.
