Skills that are important for a data scientist or statistician



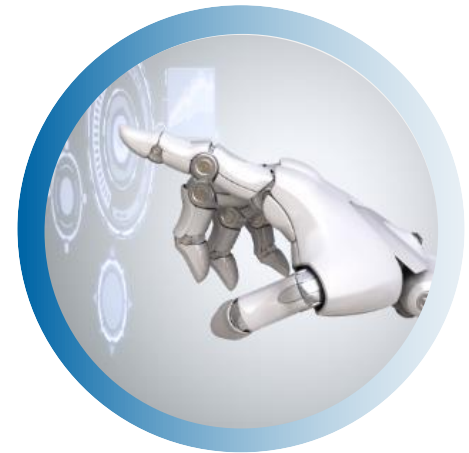
Communicate

Pull the data, use the simplest method to create a useful result
