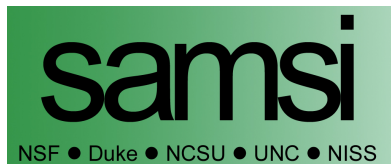

**4. ITSEW.** NISS is establishing an ongoing series international workshops on total survey error, to be known as International Total Survey Error Workshops (ITSEW, or It-So) . The purpose of ITSEW is to enable researchers interested in total survey error to meet on a regular basis, in order to review progress on important problems; define pressing current problems in detail; identify emerging research needs at an early stage; articulate a research agenda to address current and emerging problems; and form research collaborations to carry out needed research. ITSEW explicitly seeks to attract and engage problem owners as well as researchers. ITSEW will be held annually, in summer (June or July), starting in 2008, when the planned focus is *multiple sources of error* and the planned location is RTP, with NISS and RTI International (RTI) as co-hosts.
