To nominate an individual, the nominator is asked to collect 2 letters of recommendation from others, (please be sure that the names and contact information of letter writers are included), and submit both of these letters together along with your own nomination letter and the most current version of the nominee's CV and submit this as **ONE** PDF document to <u>sacksaward@niss.orq</u> by Friday, May 2, 2025: (please submit all 3 at one time/as one PDF)

- 1. Nomination letter (maximum two pages),
- 2. Supporting letters from two individuals (other than nominator), and
- 3. The nominee's most current CV.
